On June 7-8th Pastor Annie, along with HOPE's voting members, Nancy Sailer and Carl Warren, will head to Eau Claire for the annual Northwest Synod of Wisconsin Synod Assembly. This is a special year as it is a Bishop's election year! The current Bishop, Rev. Laurie Skow-Anderson, has announced her retirement and will not be seeking re-election. We are grateful for her many years in ministry on our synod staff both as Bishop and Director of Evangelical Mission!

To prepare for a new bishop our synod has introduced a new election process where candidates were pre-identified during conference meeting elections. This allows time for full background checks on candidates, the opportunity to get to know candidates better during pre-assembly forums, and more time for the Spirit to move among our synod.

In addition to electing a new Bishop, the synod assembly is when voting members from all 195 congregations across the synod gather for worship, learning about our ministry partners, hearing what God is up to in other congregations, considering important resolutions, and conducting the faithful business of our synod's ministry. Finally, the assembly will serve as a final opportunity to give toward the Bishop's "Water Is Life" initiative to raise \$40,000 for 2 new wells in Malawi. HOPE's generosity throughout Lent contributed \$1,128 toward that goal! If anyone would like to make an additional donation, you will find a link on the synod website (linked above).

We sell Kwik Trip gift cards (\$25, \$50 and \$100) and earn 5% of the purchase price back.




Olive will be out of the office starting Wednesday, May 29th until Monday, June 10th.
