

Did you know that the 2019 Churchwide Assembly of the ELCA called for the ELCA to develop a social statement on civic life and faith, the relationship of church and state, and related matters?

The ELCA has multiple social statements which serve as our "primary documents to address significant social issues. They are intended to aid reflection, shape conscience and set forth the ELCA's teaching and policy on the major social issues and questions of contemporary life. Social statements are developed by task forces, using an established process of study and widespread participation across the church to guide theological and moral deliberation" (from elca.org).

In 2023 the task force for this social statement issued a 6-session study for public feedback that informed this Draft Statement on Civic Life and Faith. Now, in the summer of 2024, congregation and synods are invited to study and provide feedback on the draft statement. Our next adult forum will provide a platform for discussion on this statement. Please join us on Sunday, July 14th for this discussion and opportunity to provide feedback.

Current Blood Inventory July 1st – July 7th:

- ⇒ Most patient orders for *Type O- blood have been reduced* due to limited quantities.
- ⇒ All *Platelet supply orders are experiencing "some" reductions* due to insufficient supplies.
- ⇒ Type *B- blood is experiencing "some" reductions* as well due to insufficient supplies.
- ⇒ All blood types are needed; *Type O Blood especially*.
- ⇒ Power Red Donors critically needed.

John and I can't be more thankful for all the meals that have been provided for us and all the meals have been fantastic! With that said, we have decided that the meal train is no longer needed.






